

Copes Corners Park Committee Meeting Minutes April 3, 2018 - 7 p.m. at park then to Town Hall

Present: Scott Wilson, Scot Lueck, Town Councilman Keith Lilley

At the park we looked over the new pavilion and the new proposed site for the playground, then came back to the Town Hall

Update on any changes with the park and update on status of planning for Spring Fest

Keith Lilley reports that there are now ten seasonal rentals for RV sites

Discussion on status of planning for Spring Fest - everything seems to be on track: event planning; marketing; park infrastructure preparation

Some discussion on 2018 goal of developing a playground - the new proposed site in the area between the north side restrooms, pavilion #3, and the white birch tree seems to be a good site in many ways and that site would be the recommendation of the committee to the Board - the site is more easily available to campers and park patrons, a water fountain could be installed in the nearby water line, patrons wishing to rent a pavilion for an activity with children present might want to choose pavilion #3 with the playground nearby, seating under the birch tree would provide shade for supervising parents - we will have the playground centerpiece wooden tractor and wagon made by Ed Wilson installed for Spring Fest and include it in the day's events

Discussion on how to meet the 2018 goal of three more summer events at the park - it is suggested that the Friends of the Park be given the chance to develop new events

Short discussion on an announcement seeking volunteers for this year's spring clean-up on April 21

The only recommendation to the Board from this non-quorum CCPC meeting is to approve the above-mentioned site for the new park playground
