

Copes Corners Park Committee Meeting Minutes 5 June, 2018 - 7 p.m.

Discussion on evolving role of the park committee - as the park has become an established part of the Town, many committee responsibilities and activities from the past few years have changed and some have become unnecessary - ideas on a vision of the committee's purpose in the future include:

- use the committee for long-range park planning
- turning over event planning to the Friends of the Park
- altering the role of the committee to a "special committee" which would only meet when given a specific task by the Town Board
- abolish the committee, replacing it with the Friends of the Park group and a group of volunteers to work on park projects
- or some combination of the above

Contact will be initiated with volunteers to plan two summer events at the park

Some discussion on non-committee projects at the park: restroom renovations and water line replacement

It was informally agreed to change meeting intervals back to once a month - next meeting scheduled for 10 July, the day before the regular Town Board meeting, to avoid the holiday the week before
