

## Copes Corners Park Committee Meeting

August 20, 2019 at 7:00 PM

The committee met at the the large pavilion at the park. The meeting opened with a discussion on how nice it was to see the park filled with campers and how well maintained it looked.

Michele had arrived early to have a run on a route from the park over Flat Iron Bridge and back to envision a possible 5K event at the park. There will be further discussion about this at the next meeting and could possibly be planned for a 2020 fall event.

Short discussion on holding an event this September. Consensus was to not hold an event this year but long-term planning should include a post-Labor Day event in 2020.

In an update on the park, Scot Lueck mentioned that there is now hot water in the restrooms. He then reminded the committee that we need a long term landscaping plan and that the current short-term goal is to plant trees that will be purchased with grant money received.

Also mentioned was a suggestion to paint park pavilion # 1.

The water system is the last project that needs to be done to complete the DASNY grant. The committee would like to see work started no later than the first two weeks of October pending availability of assistance from the Town Highway Department. Most materials have already been purchased to complete the project.

Fall cleanup at the park is set for Saturday, October 12th, pending approval from the Town Board.
