At the regular meeting of the Butternuts Town Board on November 12, 2025, the Board approved a motion to remove the entire historical collection from the Legion building before the end of the December 2025. This is in part due to a reorganization of the Town Historian's office, and the need to have more convenient access to all Town historical artifacts. This will also allow artifacts to be displayed in the Town Hall, and possibly in other places throughout the Town.

The Town Board appreciates your cooperation in storing these historical artifacts over the years. We will be in touch with you as we make arrangements to remove everything by the end of the year.

Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

Sincerely, Bruce Giuda Town Supervisor Finished developing the 2026 budget working with the Tax Assessor and Otsego County to affirm the correct assessments and valuation. Worked with the Historian to plan events and get her the necessary office equipment. We will be adding lights and outlets in the basement of the Town Hall. Met with Depot Engineering and the Department of Health at Copes Corners Park to discuss issues with the proposed upgrades. Many issues were resolved and we will be sending a letter of clarification to MYS Department of Health. Discussed plans for a new Town Hall with Depot Engineering, and I explained that the Board was not happy with any of the plans proposed. We will develop a floor plan and submit it to him for engineering the details. Sidney Federal Credit Union has been designated as an official depository for Town Funds by NY State. This due to the work that was done (mostly by the BVA) describing the area as a banking desert after Community Bank left Morris NY. There are investment opportunities that I will discuss with the Board for our savings and reserves.
